The Challenges:

Unlike in many countries in Europe and America, which have experienced many years of African migration, the immigration of Africans into Australia has been fairly recent. It all started in 1971 with the abolition of the white-Australian policy of the Commonwealth of Australia. A policy that forbade migrations into the nation from less developed nations of Asia and Africa.

The Possibilities:

We came to Australia, not because of a quest for a better life but as one sent. The Lord spoke to us about moving to Australia first in 1998, and with more clarity in 1999. All these were shared with our mentor and Pastor, Dr Tunde Bakare. We remain eternally grateful to God for his counsel and support during this period. So, coming to Australia, this became our motivation. We were under divine command, and though things were initially challenging, we remained undeterred. Though the scenarios described above were initially challenging, the Lord laid on my heart for us to focus on intercessory prayers. We started with five families, and we met every Sunday to pray. What followed were different miracles of divine provision, which eventually led to the establishment of the Church in 2008.

As a Kingdom Change Agent:

The next phase of growth was our foray into the mountain of Government. This began in 2013 when the Lord supernaturally connected us to my good friend and partner in ministry, Pastor Brian Heath. We met at a Minister's Conference, which both of us did not plan to attend, but destiny brought us together. He had just returned from the

Global Leader's Conference (GLS) in Muar, Malaysia, where Pastor (Pastor Tunde Bakare) had ministered. Pastor Brian was sharing at this Minister's meeting a particular testimony that Pastor shared there. The People were confounded, seeing the apparent unbelief on their faces; he just turned to me where I sat whether I knew anything about it. At this point, we had never met. He didn't even know whether I knew Pastor, but as he later said, he just felt the Holy Spirit nudging him to ask me about that particular event, and as God would have it, not only did I know something about it, I was actually with Pastor when he gave the prophetic word to the son of the Sultan in Sokoto at the GAIN Conference we had in Sokoto in 2005. I confirmed the event, and the entire hall was turned upside down. So the two of us though we had never met before this time, started ministering together at this Minister's Conference. There was a mighty move of the Holy Spirit at that meeting. And from that day, we started working closely together regarding the penetration of the Kingdom into the arena of politics and governance, beginning from our state of Victoria and is now gradually spreading into the entire nation.

As kingdom change agents, we are on assignment to proffer solutions to the problems and challenges that beset our various societies

Kingdom Strategies:

The Seven Mountain Strategy in our Church

Isaiah 2:2

The people in our Church are being deliberately trained to engage with the seven mountains of human endeavour. This has resulted in active engagement with the political, economic, health care delivery, and legal fields by various people from our Church. Currently, I am the Vice-Chair of the Fraser Federal Electoral Council of the ruling party in Australia and equally a member of the

State Council of the same party. In addition to my involvement, several people in our workforce hold various positions at the State and Federal levels. This has turned us into a significant force within the party in our area of domicile. As of now the party has been encouraging me to run for electoral office both at the National and State level, but I'm yet to make up my mind.



THE MULTI-LINGUAL CHURCH: STRATEGIES

FOR INFILTRATING THE MOUNTAINS OF CULTURE BY THE NOW CHURCH

The world as we knew it has changed and the unusual has become our normal and may be for some time to come.

COVID 19 is a rude awakening to us all that the church of Christ is more than a physical structure. God wants to touch the world through CHRIST IN US. The Holy Spirit is not handicapped. Evangelism doesn't end simply because we cannot invite people to our buildings. Jesus died for the world, not our building and programmes!

Like the mother eagle, God is stirring the nest so that we can learn to spread our wings and soar as we were purposed to.

Acts 2:1-15.

"Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven. ...everyone heard them speak in his own language."

The power of the gospel is in its simplicity and its universal applicability. The message is best when it is communicated in a 'language' that is clearly understood. Of course, there is the dimension of speaking mysteries unto God as a way of connecting with the spirit in prayers, worship and intercession when words are inadequate. But beyond this, we must like Moses, press into God to receive instructions to take to the people we interact with in the daily grind of life.

Language serves the purpose of communication. It is the platform of passing across a particular message in a way that resonates with the receiver. It is also a BONDING factor in any community. Language facilitates access. When you meet someone somewhere who speaks your language, you let down your guard.

The Spirit-inspired communication on the day of Pentecost totally demystified the message of the gospel and the mind of God towards humanity.

Let's consider a few key issues here: 1. DIVIDED TONGUES - speaks of individual capacity to engage a person or group of persons in intelligent discourse or communication. We must make biblical Christianity a contemporary experience by expressing KINGDOM in the language of Babylon like Daniel, Meshach, Shadrack, Abednego, Moses and Joseph in Egypt, Mordecai and Esther in Persia. Paul was so effective because he could connect to Gentiles in intellect, commerce and spirituality. What language have you been "baptized" with? Engineering, politics, sports, entertainment...? There are needy people waiting to hear the gospel in that language.

2. NATIONS FROM EVERYWHERE UNDER THE SUN

This speaks about the universality of the message and the need to specifically CONNECT it to communities and nations. A nation is a people group united in culture, nuances, perceptions, literature, language etc. Every culture revolves around certain elements that unite all the diversity of interests and opinion in that group.

We call them the seven mountains of influence. These are, politics/power, economy, religious beliefs, education, family values, science and technology, entertainment, sports etc. Every society's conduct is formulated around these constituents of a culture. The heart of God has always beaten for NATIONS!

To affect any society, you must be fluent in the language that connects with people at these points of function. Anyone with a loud voice in these areas will affect the society's conduct and direction. What you cannot influence, you cannot impact. We are looking at language here not just in the literal sense but in the sense of being able to connect with people in their lifestyle, culture and profession.

In Acts 17, Paul acknowledged the Athenians' belief system, and by referring to their literature and its relevance to the "Unknown God" that they should worship, he connected with their hunger and quest for a Supreme being.

He spoke Aramaic when he needed to speak to the Jews and got their attention. He spoke Greek in Athens and when he was to be beaten and jailed, he claimed the amnesty of his Roman citizenship!

3. SPIRIT-INSPIRED AND ENERGIZED COMMUNICATION -

this was designed to provoke a response in the hearer. Peter did not make an altar call but the hearers were so convicted that they started asking what they needed to do to encounter the Christ.

4. FROM THE KNOW TO THE UNKNOWN - Peter's message moved the people from the known to the unknown. He connected with them at the point they could

relate with. "This is that...", connecting them to a prophecy they were all familiar with. Jesus had a strategy of story-telling that resonated with His audience. You must understand how to situate the present situation in which people find themselves to the context of their need for a saviour.

God wants to reach the world in its own language, not in church language. Each of the seven mountains has its own language and we must learn the language of the one we intend to engage. Otherwise, we will be ineffective. We must stop trying to use church language to speak to street folks! They won't just get it although they may pretend to, just to get you off their backs!

There is a reason why you are planted in the midst of unbelievers or with that ungodly boss. When by your conduct and communication you are able to earn their trust, that is when your opportunity comes. You let your light shine and let them **SEE** YOUR GOOD WORKS. They will know you are different and be attracted to the brightness of your rising! But if you begin by wanting them to come into your world to speak and behave like you, you will alienate them completely and they will draw a blank around you. Learn their language. Know where they are coming from. Meet them there and draw them to where you want them to be. By then, they are already asking some private, personal questions about their lives because yours challenges them! I am an Apostle to the marketplace. I have never used hard drugs. But I had to go and learn street language to get addicts and area boys to listen to me. I engage with the corporate world a lot and became the President of the Chamber of Commerce in the city where I operate. Although not a practicing politician, I am mentor to some politicians in my state and have served on the state Judicial Service Commission. I hold the highest certification possible in Management Consultancy. I am a Certified Life Coach and recently became a licensed Mediator/Negotiator. I had to learn the language of function at all these levels.

I am sometimes introduced as 'Rev. Tope Popoola' in my corporate training sessions, and I leave participants in no doubt that my materials are inspired by scriptures, but you will never catch me using Christianese like "Glory!" "Hallelujah', "Praise the Lord', "Amen?" etc. Yet, in many cases, I have

ended up being drawn into the spiritual challenges of many of the participants and a re-evaluation of their lives and priorities in a way that makes them inquire further!!! That then becomes my opportunity to witness Christ.

This is the **SALT** and **YEAST DIMENSION** of our calling. Conquest by **INFILTRATION**. Yeast and salt are catalysts. Catalysts affect the process of a chemical reaction without undergoing a fundamental change in the process. Our Apostolic Overseer calls it "contact without contamination". Jesus referred to the yeast dimension in Matthew 13:33. For both, they are not visible in the body of food or flour but the impact of their presence is discernible. You don't need a large quantity to enhance flavour or texture as the case may be! One critical issue here is that they must first make contact before they can be effective.

The other dimension is the **LIGHT** dimension which speaks of **INVASION** and **DECLARATION**. When light shines, it invades darkness and reveals something. When you let your light shine before all men, they can see your good works and in turn, they can give glory to the One at work in you, your heavenly Father! When we shine, Gentiles are attracted to our light and the nations to the brightness of our rising. The world is currently steeped in "gross darkness". Creation is waiting for the manifestation of the sons of God. Now is the time to arise!
